  - A. Senior Calves, Sept. 1 - Dec. 31, 2007
  - B. Summer Yearlings, May 1 - Aug. 31, 2007
  - C. Jr. Yearlings, Jan. 1 - Apr. 30, 2007
  - D. Sr. Yearlings, Sept. 1 - Dec. 31, 2006
- II. Showmanship age as of Jan. 1, 2008:
  - A. Junior, 7-10
  - B. Intermediate, 11-13
  - C. Senior, 14 and Over

## III. Steers

4. Exhibitors will be responsible for clean-up of their stall area. Animals will be stalled on sand. (No Bedding Allowed)
5. Heifers will be shown by breed, in age classes. Heifers may be co-owned and co-registered by two or more 4-H members of the same family. Registration papers will be requested on heifers for proof of age.
6. Steers will be shown in breed classes, divided by weight.
7. The show committee will have the final decision on breed classification and class divisions.
