

# SHOW RULES

## Chico State's 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Northern Exposure Junior Cattle Show

October 17-18, 2009 Glenn Co. Fairgrounds – Orland, CA

---

### General Information/Rules:

1. All steer exhibitors must be ages 9-19 as of January 1, 2009 and Breeding Cattle exhibitors must be 21 and under as of January 1, 2009. These ages apply to those planning on gaining CJLA points from the Northern Exposure Show. The management reserves the right to adjust these ages if the need arises and we will adhere to specific breed rules (for heifer exhibitors) as well.
2. Entry fees for Show A:
  - Steers and Heifers - \$40 per head
  - Showmanship - \$10 per entry
3. Entry fees for Show B:
  - Steers and Heifers - \$30 per head
  - Showmanship - \$10 per entry

**\*\*ONLY** animals entered in Show A can be entered in Show B. You must have an animal entered in Show B to participate in Show B Showmanship (including the animal you choose to use in showmanship).

4. Entries must be postmarked by October 2, 2009. Late entries will be accepted prior to the show, provided space permits. Late entries will be charged an additional fee.
5. **There will be NO REFUNDS on entries paid to Chico State's Northern Exposure after the October 2, 2009 entry deadline!!!!** Prior to the deadline and with adequate reasoning, 50% of the paid entry fees may be refunded depending on the current financial state of the Northern Exposure Jr. Cattle Show.
6. **The Chico State's Northern Exposure reserves the right to refuse an individual's entries if necessary (no matter the reason)!!**
7. Management reserves the right to change anything that will better accommodate and/or improve the show.
8. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
9. Bedding (straw or shavings) can be provided by the exhibitor or it will be available for purchase. Please use designated dumping areas only!!
10. Exhibitors are responsible for removing their own bedding to the designated dumping areas. Failure to remove bedding will result in a @20 fine per head and/or withholding of premiums.
11. Ethical treatment of all animals and ethical conduct from the exhibitor is expected at Northern Exposure.
12. Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious or unsightly conditions will not be permitted to show at the Northern Exposure Junior Cattle Show as determined by a veterinarian.
13. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
14. PLEASE bring generators – power may be limited.
15. No dogs will be allowed at or around the show ring.

# SHOW RULES

## Heifer Show

1. All heifers must be registered in the name of the exhibitors – and the original papers must be presented at check-in. Check-in will take place Friday evening and Saturday morning until 7:00 AM. Registration papers must be checked by 7:00 AM Saturday morning.
2. All breeding cattle exhibitors are required to send a copy of the official registration papers with entry forms and the ORIGINAL REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE REQUIRED AT “SHOW CHECK-IN”.
3. The heifer show will have 7 breed divisions. Heifer divisions are as follows: Hereford (polled and horned combined), Angus, Shorthorn, Maine-Anjou (including Maintainers), Limousin (Fall Classic), Charolais, and All Other Breeds. We will also be offering a commercial/grade (non-registered) heifer division that **WILL NOT** be included for CJLA points or Supreme Female judging.
4. If a breed does not have at least 5 entries, management reserves the right to move these animals into the AOB classes. Management also reserves the right to make any changes to the show that will benefit the outcome of events!
5. We will be hosting the “Fall Classic Limousin Show” within our heifer show again this year.
6. **\*\*NEW\*\*** There will be a cow/calf class within each breed this year. Cow Calf will not compete for Supreme Female. Please indicate cow/calf and breed in the “breed box” on the entry form. Fill in the COW information, and include her and the calf’s registration papers for processing. Please make note “calf” on the calf’s registration papers.

## Steer Show

1. Official steer weigh-in will take place Saturday, October 17, 2009 from 5:00 – 7:00 PM. We will also weigh steers from 7:00 – 8:00 am on Sunday morning.
2. The steer show will have two weight divisions: Prospect and Progress. Northern Exposure management will break and post classes on the day of the show. At this time, a division break of light/heavy may occur.
3. There will be three breed divisions: British (Angus, Hereford and Shorthorn steers will show together), AOC (all other color) and Black./Black X. Official breeds will be called at the scale. Management’s decision is FINAL!!!

## Showmanship

1. Cattle Showmanship (age as of January 1, 2009): Junior Division (12 & under) Intermediate Division (13-15) and Senior Division (16-21). Steer and Heifer showmanship are combined. Show A showmanship on Saturday and Show B showmanship on Sunday.
2. All exhibitors must show their own animal. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
3. Exhibitor must have an animal entered in Show B to be eligible for Show B Showmanship.
4. FITTING IS OPTIONAL FOR SHOWMANSHIP!!
