Stalling will be available for one animal per participant. Pens **MUST** be cleaned prior to departure. Please bring appropriate tools to clean your stalling area.

There WILL NOT be a clipping portion during the Division I camp. All cattle should come pre clipped to the clinic. We feel that there is not ample time to include a clipping portion, and that clipping mistakes can hurt the youngsters' confidence as well as affect the cattle's performance at shows following the camp. We will be happy to answer questions on clipping, but intense one on one instruction is needed to effectively teach clipping practices.

Each exhibitor should also bring a fitting chute, blower, washing materials, shavings, shavings fork, shovel, **generator if possible**, show halter, show stick, tack box etc.

After registration, a DETAILED product list will be sent to each participant so that you can come prepared with all of the products to complete all of the hands on sessions.
