Welcome to Showtime's Northern Exposure "Fiesta Edition"! We are overly excited to be partnering with Farmers Best Feed and Showtime Feeds in the production of this year's show.



General Information/Rules:

1. All exhibitors must be 22 and under as of January 1, 2021
2. Entry fees:
 - Hogs, Sheep, Goats & Wether Dams - \$35 per entry
 - Steers and Heifers - \$45 per entry
 - Showmanship - \$10 per entry
3. Entries must be submitted by March 1, 2021. Late entries will be accepted prior to the show, provided space permits. Late entries will be charged an additional fee (\$25/head/show). Late entries will have to rent stalls or show out of trailer.
4. Online entries www.showman.app – entries due March 1st!!
 - a. Apparel orders are included in the online entry portal in the "questions" section
 - b. Facility use accommodations and fees are included in the online entry portal in the "questions" section
5. NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS – shavings will be available for purchase in the online entry portal in the "questions" section. Outside pelleted bedding is permitted.
6. PEN OPTIONS: NO PENS WILL BE PROVIDED for hogs, sheep, or goats!!
 - a. Hogs: rent horse stalls and/or show out of trailers (see #8 below)
 - b. Sheep & Goats: rent horse stalls and/or show out of trailers (see #8 below)
 - c. Cattle: tie space will be assigned with your entry, unless you indicate that you are renting horse stalls or showing out of trailers (see #8 below). There is NO POWER in the barns where tie space is provided, and tack space is EXTREMELY limited. I highly recommend renting a horse stall if you do not have a generator, or if you like to set up chutes. Power is limited at the horse stalls, but it does exist. Horse stalls are also available as a nighttime turnout option, just indicate tie space and renting stalls in the "questions" section.

7. SHOW SET UP:
 - a. Hogs will be showing in a tent located at the west end of the facility (near the entrance/exit gate) with access to the horse stalls for those needing that option for penning. There will be accessible washracks to be used. There will be ample trailer parking for those showing out of their trailers (see #8 below, trailer fee). Set up will be similar to our show last March, and CYE in August. We will be having an online auction (wlivestock.com) for assigned trailer parking, this will be a convenience fee IN ADDITION to the trailer fee (see #9 below)
 - b. Sheep & Goats will be showing in the large pavilion. Sheep & Goat exhibitors that choose to rent horse stalls will be in the stalls west of the pavilion (nearest washrack) unless otherwise requested. Sheep & goats showing out of trailers will park on the north side of the office/outdoor arenas as in the past (see #8 below, trailer fee). Sheep & goat exhibitors can also rent an RV spot to park your livestock trailer, RV fees apply (see #8 below).
 - c. Cattle will be showing in the large pavilion. Cattle exhibitors that choose to rent horse stalls will be in the stalls east of the pavilion unless otherwise requested.
8. Facility Use Fees (to be requested/paid in the "questions" section of the online entry portal)
 - Trailer fee, \$50/trailer for those showing out of their trailers (not in an RV spot). The fee DOES NOT apply if an RV spot has been rented for the trailer to be parked in. The fee does not apply to trailers that aren't being used to show out of.
 - Horse Stall fee \$25/night/stall. Horse stall reservations will be available on the online entry portal (www.showman.app) There will be a place to make stalling requests on your entry as well.
 - RV fee \$45/night RV reservations will be available on the online entry portal (www.showman.app). Special requests will be granted via auction format (see #9 below)
 - MUST COMPLETE the "questions" section on the online entry portal
9. ***** NEW IN 2021 ***** as mentioned above, we will have an auction on www.wlivestock.com (March 3, 2021) for several premium amenities. The auction price is an ADDITIONAL convenience fee. Trailer, stall, and RV fees must be paid on the online entry portal PRIOR to participating in the auction. Included in the sale will be (to name a few) assigned hog trailer spots, covered cattle pens, RV spots and premium horse stalls
10. Exhibitors showing out of their trailers MUST leave the area how you found it. CLEAN UP all shavings, trash, feed and manure from your area before departure.
11. Livestock MUST be washed in designated WASH areas!! NO washing in aisles between the stalls or at your trailers. ZERO TOLLERANCE for this as well as ANY damage to the horse stalls. No writing on stall walls, no tape or glue on the stalls, no paint on the stalls ETC!!! BE RESPECTFUL of the beautiful facility that we are fortunate enough to be able to use!!!!
12. **There will be NO REFUNDS on entries paid to Northern Exposure or facility use fees paid via showman.app!!!!**
13. Management reserves the right to change **anything** that will better accommodate and/or improve the show.
14. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
15. **NEW in 2021*** The sheep and goat show will have some overlap due to rings running simultaneously. If you enter both species, MAKE SURE you have alternate showmen!! We will not hold up weight classes for exhibitors with overlap.**
16. Please use designated dumping areas only!! NO TRASH in bedding/manure dump areas!! Upon departure, bedding DOES NOT have to be removed from cattle tie space or horse stalls. However, please remove all trash!!
17. **Ethical treatment of all animals and ethical conduct from the exhibitor is expected at Northern Exposure.**
18. Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious or unsightly conditions will not be permitted to show at Northern Exposure as determined by a veterinarian.

19. Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
20. PLEASE bring generators – power is limited.
21. No dogs will be allowed at or around the show ring.
22. OUT OF STATE EXHIBITORS **MUST** have appropriate health inspections and brand inspections!
23. Payouts will depend on the success of the show. All expenses must be paid prior to payouts being decided or disbursed. The Northern Exposure Events are self-sustaining and run independently on entry fees and sponsorships alone. There are no outside funds supporting these events!! Thank you for your consideration.
24. **NEW IN 2021*** due to COVID 19 and the uncertainty and time constraint, we will be awarding banners and cash payouts to division and overall champions ONLY!! No individual class payouts and NO ADDITIONAL AWARDS (jackets, buckles, cups, cords, etc)!!! We are showing “COVID style”! We can arrange the purchasing of award buckles or jackets, but expense will be covered by the exhibitor!**
25. There will be a COVID waiver, release of liability sent out prior to the show that must be completed and provided at the gate upon arrival!

Hog Show

1. **NEW IN 2021*** hogs will show by (breed) in ALL 3 SHOWS!!**
2. The hog show will have the following breeds divisions: Berkshire, Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, All Other Purebred – Light, All Other Purebred – Dark, Light Crossbred, Dark Crossbred. You will self-classify your own hogs! The classifications will be at the discretion of the judge. If the judge deems a hog mis-classified, the judge has the discretion to move the hog to the appropriate division.
3. The above-mentioned breeds will be broken into lightweight (160 lbs and below) and heavyweight (161 lbs and above) divisions. Champion and Reserve will be chosen in these divisions to compete for the Champion, Res. Champion, and 3rd overall in each breed.
4. Boars can be shown up to 135 lbs.
5. Animals must be entered in Show B to be eligible for Show B Showmanship. Same applies for Show C.
6. Each exhibitor **MUST** show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.

Hog Showmanship

1. Showmanship (age as of January 1, 2021): Pee Wee (8 & under) Junior Division (9-12) Intermediate Division (13-15) and Senior Division (16-22).
2. All exhibitors must show their own animal. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
3. Exhibitor must have an animal entered in Show B to be eligible for Show B Showmanship. Same applies for Show C.

Goat Show

1. The goat show will have three divisions: Prospect, Progress and Market. Classes will be broken and posted the day of the show following official weigh-in.
2. Animals must be entered in Show B to be eligible for Show B Showmanship.

Sheep Show

1. **NEW IN 2021*** sheep will show by breed/color divisions!!**
2. The sheep show will have the following breeds/color divisions: hair, whiteface/speck, natural & blackface.
3. The above-mentioned breeds will be broken into prospect, progress market divisions. Champion and Reserve will be chosen in these divisions to compete for the Champion, Res. Champion and 3rd overall in each breed/color.
4. Animals must be entered in Show B to be eligible for Show B Showmanship.

Wether Dam Ewe & Doe Show

1. **NEW IN 2021*** Wether Dam Ewes will show by breed/color divisions (hair, whiteface/speck, natural & blackface)** and will be broken further into divisions, lightweight/heavyweight after weigh-in.
2. Wether dams CAN BE dual entered in the jackpot show/wether dam show!!
3. Wether dams will be evaluated as breeding animals.
4. Wether dams must have milk teeth or yearling teeth.
5. Wether dams must have an ear tag or permanent legible tattoo, prior to weigh-in.
6. Structural correctness disqualifications are at the discretion of the judge.
7. Does may be shown with or without horns.
8. Does may be shown with or without being slick shorn.
9. All doe and ewe classes will be broken by weight.
10. Wether dam does will have two divisions: lightweight/heavyweight. Determined after weigh-in.

Sheep and Goat Showmanship

1. Showmanship (age as of January 1, 2021): Pee Wee (8 & under) Junior Division (9-12) Intermediate Division (13-15) and Senior Division (16-22).
2. All exhibitors must show their own animal. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
3. Exhibitor must have an animal entered in Show B to be eligible for Show B Showmanship.
4. FITTING IS OPTIONAL FOR SHOWMANSHIP!!

Steer Show

1. The steer show will have three breed divisions: British (Purebred Angus, Red Angus, Hereford and Shorthorn (to be shown together), AOC (All Other Colors), and Black/Black X. Official breed classification will be verified at the scale. Management's decision is final!!
2. The steer show will have two divisions (lightweight & heavyweight) within the above-mentioned breeds. Classes will be broken and posted the day of the show following official weigh-in.
3. Each exhibitor MUST show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.

Market Heifer Division

1. The Market Heifer Show will NOT be broken by breed, ONLY by weight. There WILL NOT be a prospect, progress, market division champions. ONLY an overall champion market heifer will be selected.
2. The overall Champion Market Heifer will compete in the Supreme "Steer" Selection.
3. Northern Exposure management will break and post the classes on the day of the show following official weigh-in.
4. Weight discrepancies must be decided before the animal leaves the scale.

Heifer Show

1. All heifers must be registered in the name of the exhibitors – and the original papers must be presented at check-in.
2. ****NEW**** The heifer show will have the following divisions: Hereford, Angus, Maine-Anjou (including Maintainers), Charolais, Chi, Mini Hereford, Simmental (50% and above) and AOB. We will also be offering a commercial/grade (non-registered) heifer division that **WILL NOT** be included for Supreme Female judging.

Cattle Showmanship

1. Cattle Showmanship (age as of January 1, 2021): Pee Wee (8 & under) Junior Division (9-12) Intermediate Division (13-15) and Senior Division (16-22).
2. **Steer and Heifer showmanship are combined.**
3. **Show A showmanship on Friday (steers and heifers), Show B showmanship on Saturday (steers and heifers), Show C showmanship on Sunday.**
4. All exhibitors must show their own animal. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
5. FITTING IS OPTIONAL FOR SHOWMANSHIP!!
6. You must have an animal entered in Show A/Show B/Show C to participate in Show A/Show B/Show C Showmanship (including the animal you choose to use in showmanship).
