Welcome to Showtime's Northern Exposure "Fall Classic" Edition! We are very excited to be partnering with Farmers Best Feed and Showtime Feeds in the production of this year's show.



General Information/Rules:

- 1. Online entries available at <u>www.showman.app.</u> Entry deadline October 27, 2021. Late entries will be accepted prior to the show, provided space permits. Late entries will be charged an additional fee. All late entries are REQUIRED to purchase horse stalls for stalling.
 - a. Apparel orders are included in the online entry portal in the "questions" section
 - b. Facility use accommodations and fees are included in the online entry portal in the "questions" section
- All steer exhibitors must be 19 and under as of January 1, 2021 and breeding cattle exhibitors must be 22 and under as of January 1, 2021. The management reserves the right to adjust these ages if the need arises and we will adhere to specific breed rules (for heifer exhibitors) as well.
- 3. Entry fees for Show A:
 - Steers and Heifers \$45 per head
 - Showmanship \$10 per entry
- 4. Entry fees for Show B:
 - Steers and Heifers \$45 per head
 - Showmanship \$10 per entry
- 5. Entry feed for Friday Heifer Open Jackpot
 - \$50 per head
- 6. <u>There will be NO REFUNDS on entry fees paid to Northern Exposure or facility use fees paid to Rolling Hills Equestrian</u> <u>Center!!!!</u>
- 7. Management reserves the right to change **anything** that will better accommodate and/or improve the show.
- 8. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.
- 9. ***NEW in 2021*** NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS will be permitted at the RHEC facility. They are available for purchase on the online entry portal \$10/bag and will be available upon arrival for purchase. PRICE INCLUDES REMOVAL!!! PLEASE order your first bedding online, when submitting entries so we can have an accurate count. Please use designated dumping areas only!! Bedding pellets from outside sources are permitted. Exhibitors are responsible for removing all feed, hay and garbage but bedding will be removed by the facility staff. Failure to remove these articles will result in a @ \$20 fine per head and/or withholding of premiums.

- 10. Ethical treatment of all animals and ethical conduct from the exhibitor is expected at Northern Exposure.
- **11.** Any animal exhibiting signs of infectious or unsightly conditions will not be permitted to show at the Northern Exposure Junior Cattle Show as determined by a veterinarian.
- **12.** Any animal that is deemed a safety hazard by show management will be disqualified with no refund.
- **13.** PLEASE bring generators power is EXTREMELY limited.
- 14. No dogs will be allowed at or around the show ring.
- 15. OUT OF STATE EXHIBITORS MUST have appropriate health inspections and brand inspections!
- 16. HORSE STALLS: horse stall reservations will be available on the online entry portal (www.showman.app).
- 17. RV RENTAL: RV reservations will be available on the online entry portal.
- 18. ****** NEW IN 2020 ****** we will be hosting an auction on www.wlivestock.com. Included in the auction will be covered pens, uncovered pens, preferred horse stalls and RV spaces. This provides an opportunity for special requests for horse stalls and RV's to be granted for a small convenience fee. The convenience fee will be in addition to the reservation fee paid on the online entry portal. Reservation fee MUST be paid through the online entry portal prior to purchasing in the auction.
- 19. NEW IN 2020 due to COVID 19 and the uncertainty and time constraint, we will be awarding banners and cash payouts to division and overall champions ONLY!! No individual class payouts! Supreme, Reserve Supreme, Champion B&O, and the Open Heifer Jackpot will receive BUCKLES!!! We are showing "COVID style"! We can arrange the purchasing of other award buckles or jackets, but expense will be covered by the exhibitor!

NEW IN 2021 FRIDAY HEIFER JACKPOT

- 1. No minimum or maximum age for exhibitors.
- 2. \$1000 added money for Supreme Champion Heifer & a Buckle!
- 3. Registered heifers born after November 10, 2019.
- 4. The following breed divisions will be offered: Hereford, Mini Hereford, Angus, Maine-Anjou (including Maintainers), Chi, Simmental (50% and above), AOB and Charolais.

Steer Show

- 1. Official Steer weigh-in will take place Friday evening. There will be **NO** weigh-in on Saturday morning! If you aren't able to make it for weigh-in, contact Natalie (530)682-0356 for other options.
- 2. The steer show will have three breed divisions: British (Purebred Angus, Red Angus, Hereford and Shorthorn (to be shown together), AOC (All Other Colors), and Black/Black X. Official breed classification will be verified at the scale. Management's decision is final!!
- **3.** The steer show will have two divisions (lightweight & heavyweight) within the above-mentioned breeds. Classes will be broken and posted the day of the show following official weigh-in.
- **4.** Each exhibitor MUST show his/her own animal. Any exception must be approved prior to the show by the show management. If, and only if, a showman is currently showing one animal and has another animal to show simultaneously, an alternate showman is acceptable.

Market Heifer Division

- 1. The Market Heifer Show will NOT be broken by breed, ONLY by weight.
- 2. ***New in 2021*** A lightweight and heavyweight champion and reserve will be selected in the Market Heifer Division.
- 3. The overall Champion Market Heifer will compete in the Supreme "Steer" Selection.
- 4. Northern Exposure management will break and post the classes on the day of the show following official weigh-in.
- 5. Weight discrepancies must be decided before the animal leaves the scale.

Heifer Show

- 1. All heifers must be registered in the name of the exhibitors and the original papers must be presented at check-in.
- **NEW** The heifer show will have the following divisions: Hereford, Mini Hereford, Angus, Maine-Anjou (including Maintainers), Chi, Simmental (50% and above), AOB and Charolais. We will also be offering a commercial/grade (nonregistered) heifer division that WILL NOT be included for Supreme Female judging.

Bred & Owned Heifer Show

- 1. Bred & Owned heifers can be multiply entered, they don't have to be shown solely in bred & owned.
- 2. All breeds shown together, by age.
- 3. Champion B&O Female will be awarded a buckle!

Cattle Showmanship

- 1. Cattle Showmanship (age as of January 1, 2021): Pee Wee (8 & under) Junior Division (9-12) Intermediate Division (13-15) and Senior Division (16-22).
- 2. Steer and Heifer showmanship are combined.
- 3. Show A showmanship on Saturday (steers and heifers), Show B showmanship on Sunday.
- 4. All exhibitors must show their own animal. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
- 5. FITTING IS OPTIONAL FOR SHOWMANSHIP!!
- **6.** You must have an animal entered in Show A/Show B to participate in Show A/Show B Showmanship (including the animal you choose to use in showmanship).
- 7. Exceptions may be made for PeeWee Showmen, or exhibitors that don't have an animal at the show.
